Where

Karaburun-Sazan National Marine Park is the first Marine Protected Area in Albania, encompassing 12,437.7 hectares and home to several important habitats and species.

The park's management approach was recently updated to include a local NGO, Flag Pine, in co-management with the **Regional Administration of Protected Areas Vlore**.

What to Expect

This project aims to **raise awareness** and **promote the protection and conservation of biodiversity in Karaburun-Sazan MPA**. Specific objectives include increasing awareness of the park's importance, engaging youths in environmental education, and promoting the SPAMI List. Activities will include producing awareness-raising materials, using the slogan **#NeJemiSPAMI** (**#WeAreSPAMI**), organizing school visits to the Visitor Center and Sea Turtle Rehabilitation Center, designing murals and creating dedicated spaces for environmental education in one pilot school.

The mini project will be implemented by **Flag Pine** with the support of **RAPA Vlore**. Funding will be provided by **Flag Pine** as in-kind contribution and **SPA/RAC**, through the **SPAMI Twinning Programme**, implemented under the cooperation agreement between **UNEP/MAP-Secretariat** of the **Barcelona Convention** and the **Italian Ministry of Environment and Energy Security**.
